The recorded training sessions will be posted on the Workforce Professionals Center (WPC), within the Workforce Monitoring Tools page, as they are completed.

Once the monitoring tools are finalized and additional recorded training modules become available, they will be posted to the WPC site. The goal is to finalize all monitoring tools by September 26, 2025.
