I just wanted to let you know that, for *ETO Data Entry TA Support Session 4: Employment Rate or Education Rate – After Exit PM Dashboard*, held on 1/16/2025, the recording and FAQs, that came out of it, are now available on the WPC <u>DOL Employment Rate (Non-Youth) or Education & Employment Rate (Youth Only) – After Exit PM Dashboard webpage.</u>

Please keep in mind that the Employment Rate <u>Functional Requirements Documentation</u> (Step by step, on how to enter the data into ETO, for the dashboard) (Last Updated: 12/31/24) goes in lock step together with the new Employment Rate TA Session recording, and they have extra valuable information included in them, of which were not necessarily spoken to in the Employment Rate TA Session.

And also keep in mind, that the Employment Rate <u>Business Requirements Documentation</u> (DOL business definitions (DOL laws, regulations, and guidance), for the dashboard) (Last Updated: 12/31/24) supports the Employment Rate <u>Functional</u> <u>Requirements Documentation</u>, with the new <u>1 to 1</u> correlation of the two documents, that we explained in our Employment Rate TA Session.

The <u>1 to 1</u> correlation of the *Business* and *Functional* requirements applies to all of our WPC <u>Department of Labor (DOL)</u> <u>reports</u> dashboards.

A suggestion is to use the <u>Business Requirements</u> as a table of contents, for the <u>Functional Requirements</u>, starting with <u>REQ 7</u>, on page 6, in both documents. The <u>requirements numbering sequence</u> is the same in both documents. The <u>Business Requirements</u> are more condensed and easier to identify which requirements need to be fulfilled.

For both the Denominator and the Numerator, decipher/identify which <u>Business Requirement</u>, in which you are trying to fulfill, and then go to the <u>Functional Requirements</u> and fulfill it in ETO.

- First fulfill the Denominator and then fulfill the Numerator.
- For both the Denominator and the Numerator, all of the AND clauses must be met.
- For both the Denominator and the Numerator, the <u>OR</u> clauses are your list of options, and one of the options must be met.
 - Fulfill the appropriate <u>OR</u> clause.
