Hello all,

The DI team has some good news to share, with an announcement in that the submission/certification process, for the <u>DOL</u> <u>PY24Q2</u> <u>PIRL</u> <u>Quarterly Report</u> has now been concluded, and that the PIRL data has been sent to DOL. And that our WPC <u>Department of Labor (DOL) reports</u> dashboards have been refreshed to reflect the new <u>DOL</u> <u>PY24Q2</u> <u>PIRL</u> <u>Quarterly Report</u>.

A. Updated Dashboards

- The data results, for the <u>DOL PIRL PM dashboards</u>, are <u>equal</u> to the <u>official</u> DOL Quarterly Performance Reports (QPRs) data sets, for the PY24Q2, at <u>both</u> the <u>statewide</u> and <u>local</u> (LWDBs) levels, and at the PIRL <u>Federal Grants (Funding Sources)</u> level, and at the <u>DOL Performance Measures (PMs)</u> level, all of which are defined, developed, maintained and produced, by DOL.
- 2) The data results, for the <u>DOL QRA dashboards</u>, are <u>equal</u> to the DOL Quarterly Reporting Analysis (QRAs) (aka, by DOL, as the PIRL Data Integrity (DI) reports) data sets, for the PY24Q2, at the <u>statewide</u> level, and at the PIRL <u>Federal Grants (Funding Sources)</u> level, and at the <u>Quarterly Reporting Analysis (QRAs)</u> level, all of which are defined, developed, maintained and produced, by DOL.
 - WA state does not currently receive *local* (LWDBs) level data, from DOL, for the QRAs, yet.
 - The DOL QRAs are <u>not</u> currently outlined in DOL <u>official</u> guidance (TEGLs, TENs), and are currently <u>only</u> in a "pilot" stage, by DOL, <u>for some of the states</u>. WA state is <u>not</u> one of the "pilot" states, and is only currently being monitored, by DOL, for the QRAs. But the DI team has been verbally told by DOL, in an official DOL <u>national</u> ZOOM call, that DOL is on the horizon for laying out all of the DOL QRAs, in official DOL guidance (TEGLs, TENs).
 - The DI team is not clear, once <u>official</u> DOL guidance is released by DOL, for the QRAs, on whether the QRAs will <u>only</u> be held accountable, by DOL, at the <u>statewide</u> level, or if the QRAs' accountability will <u>also</u> be held, by DOL, at the <u>local</u> (LWDB) level.
 - Our <u>DOL QRA dashboards</u>, allow the data to be pulled at <u>both</u> the <u>statewide</u> and <u>local</u> (LWDB) levels.
- 3) The data results, for the <u>MSFW Monitor Advocate Status Report Dashboard</u>, are <u>equal</u> to the <u>official</u> DOL MSFW Monitor Advocate Report data results, for PY24Q2 at the <u>statewide</u> level, and at the PIRL <u>Federal</u> <u>Grants (Funding Sources)</u> level, and at the <u>MSFW Performance Measures</u> level, all of which are defined, developed, maintained and produced, by DOL.
 - WA state does not currently receive <u>local</u> (LWDBs) level data, from DOL, for the <u>official</u> DOL MSFW Monitor Advocate Report, yet, but our <u>MSFW Monitor Advocate Status Report Dashboard</u>, allows the data to be pulled at <u>both</u> the <u>statewide</u> and <u>local</u> (LWDB) levels.
- 4) The data results, for the <u>PIRL Exiters by Longevity</u> dashboard is <u>equal</u> to the DOL PIRL Quarterly Report PIRL data results, for PY24Q2, of which is available at <u>both</u> the <u>statewide</u> and <u>local</u> (LWDB) levels.
- 5) The data results, for the <u>PIRL Participants by Category (aka the PIRL "Slicer & Dicer")</u> dashboard is <u>equal</u> to the DOL PIRL Quarterly Report PIRL data results, for PY24Q2, of which is available at <u>both</u> the <u>statewide</u> and <u>local</u> (LWDB) levels.

B. Important Note


For all of our WPC <u>Department of Labor (DOL) reports</u> dashboards, there was a recent <u>LWDB PIRL script incident fix</u>, of which was applied starting PY23Q4 and going forward, of which also <u>directly</u> affected the LWDB/WDA slicer.

- 1) <u>LWDB PIRL Script Incident</u>: If a job seeker has received services in multiple LWDBs, the offices were not always put into the correct LWDB/WDA, for the performance measures.
 - The percentage of records that were affected by this PIRL script incident is very small.
 - Note: See the <u>November 12, 2024</u> Subject: WPC DOL Reports' Webpage Announcement -Enhancement of an LWDB Slicer general announcement, for more information, regarding how the LWDB slicer was implemented for the WPC <u>Department of Labor (DOL) reports</u> enhancement.
- 2) Keep in mind, that the recent <u>LWDB PIRL script incident fix</u> <u>did not and could not fix</u> the quarterly <u>historical</u> data sets, provided on all of our WPC <u>Department of Labor (DOL) reports</u> dashboards.
 - <u>Only the quarters going forward</u>, starting with **PY23Q4**, will reflect the recent <u>LWDB PIRL script incident</u> <u>fix</u>.
 - Those quarterly <u>historical</u> data sets <u>will still display</u> data by LWDB, <u>but</u> keep in mind <u>the LWDB PIRL</u> script incident fix will not have been applied to those quarterly historical data sets.
 - This is because WA state cannot refresh/resubmit a previous PIRL. Once a PIRL has been certified and reported/sent to DOL, its data stays the same for life.
 - This means, you may see offices that you don't expect to see within the Office slicer, once you select an LWDB, and then go to select an Office. Those offices won't go away until all <u>historical</u> <u>data</u>, portrayed on our WPC <u>Department of Labor (DOL) reports</u> dashboards, has elapsed (Currently, 8 quarters need to elapse (See example in Section B.3 below).
 - FYI The DI team has <u>not found</u> any significant data in any of those offices. There is just a count of one or two job seekers, here and there.

C. Exception: DOL TAADI Dashboard

Exception: The DI team's *DOL TAADI dashboard* data sets *have not been* refreshed, and will have their next refresh, for the *DOL PY24Q2 PIRL Quarterly Report* PIRL data, soon.

1) Data Results

• Each quarter, after the quarterly PIRL submission/certification has been concluded and the data has been sent to DOL, the <u>DOL TAADI dashboard</u> takes a little longer to include the new data sets, as the DI team needs to wait for DOL to send their TAADI results, to WA state, for the most recent quarter. (DOL derives the TAADI's results/outcomes for WA state and then sends the data sets to us). Typically, it takes a month or so, after the submission/certification of a quarterly PIRL report, for the TAADI data sets to be available, within our <u>DOL TAADI dashboard</u>.

D. DOL Quarterly Performance Reports (QPRs) for PY24Q2 are now available

With the submission/certification of the **DOL PY24Q2 PIRL Quarterly Report,** all of the <u>DOL Quarterly Performance</u> <u>Reports (QPRs)</u> (defined, developed, maintained and produced, by DOL), have been run and posted, and are available on the DI team's WPC <u>Department of Labor (DOL) reports</u> website here: <u>Most recent QPR data, which represents</u> <u>the data of the most recent certified PIRL</u>.
